

The US Census Bureau has made the decision to move up the deadline for responding to the Census by a full month – from October 31st to September 30th. This change hurts West Virginia and hinders our efforts to paint an accurate portrait of our population. West Virginia desperately needs your help. Please share this information with your neighbors and friends and encourage them to respond to the 2020 Census.

Right now, our state has one of the lowest 2020 Census response rates in the country. Only 55.1% of West Virginians have responded to the census, which means that we will lose out on billions of dollars in federal funding. Every individual person in West Virginia who does not respond to the Census equates to \$20,000 in federal funds West Virginia and our communities will lose over the next ten years. If 100 West Virginians don't respond, that's \$2 million lost in federal funds to West Virginia. We simply cannot afford that.



Also, if you have a fire hydrant in your yard please keep it clear and accessible. Don't have fences, landscaping, or other obstacles blocking it from view or use. Remember, that could be YOUR house on fire and the Fire Dept. may not be able to get to the hydrant!
