We cordially invite you to participate in our annual Christmas parade to be held on **December 4, 2021**, in Vienna, WV. All units, including cars, **must be decorated for Christmas.**

No live Santa's, please!

The parade will form at Grand Central Ave. and 47th Street and end at 23rd Street. Line-up begins at 9:30 a.m. **The parade will start at 11:00 a.m.** Please, no stopping along the parade route unless there is an emergency.

The entry fee is at least a case of canned food for the Good Samaritan Center. On the day of the parade the City will provide a drop-off trailer at 47th Street off Grand Central Ave. for your non-perishable food donations. Food can also be dropped off at the Good Samaritan Center located at the Wayside Methodist Church at 3001 Grand Central Ave. on Mondays and Wednesdays from 1-3 p.m.

Suggested food donation items: Hamburger/Tuna Helper, evaporated milk, chicken broth, macaroni & cheese, stuffing mix, soups, peanut butter, cake mixes and frosting, cranberry sauce, canned pumpkin, sweet potatoes, Jell-O, or pudding (regular or sugar-free), and all canned vegetables or fruit.
